RULES

Min 5 Max 7 Players at a time

Either kids or adults (not both, or give kids a point handicap)

Only 1 bunny won per set of players

Everyone wins a prize

Winner with most points goes first

GAME 1

Chopstick Game

Move LEGO bricks from one container to the other using chopsticks only.

May use 1 or both hands

Move only 1 brick at a time.

Timed game, 1 minute

GAME 2

Knock Em Down Game

Using the 3 balls, knock down as many pieces of standing wood as you can.

10 points per piece of wood knocked down.

If one piece knocks another down, you get 10 points for that piece also.

GAME 3

Fishing Game

The fish have eaten all our LEGO. You need to find the colors you want to build with.

The gamemaster (game runner) calls out 2 colors you will look for when you fish.

Use the magnetized stick to fish for just one bubble fish.

Look for the 2 colors. 10 points for each LEGO brick with your assigned color.

Place bricks back into the fish and return the fish to the ocean.
